A catholic priest and his servant drive around until they come to place where they perform a little service. A parody on the catholic church and especially it's interest for money.

Rashers (Great Britain,Sweden)

"Hooray and up she rises!" Those words will probably be heard when Rashers play. Three musicians perform british/irish music.

Pain Solution (Norway)

Fakirskolens final exam is a real fakir show. Everything shown on stage is genuine and presented with humour, elegance and dark undertones.

Tumble Circus (Northern Ireland)

Nouvelle Carny is an autobiographical tale told by the trapeze-duo Tumble Circus. A Belfast boy and a Swedish girl fall in and out of love all the while they are swinging each other in the air.
